


1. Putty Installation:

- a. Download PuTTY from [the official site](#). We chose to download the [PuTTY Installer for Windows](#).
- b. Run putty-x.x-installer.msi, and select "Next". (Current version putty-0.67-installer.msi)
- c. By default, the installer will install in C:\Program Files (x86)\PuTTY (C:\Program Files\PuTTY for 32-bit systems)

2. WinSCP Installation

- a. Navigate to <https://winscp.net/eng/download.php> and click on installation package
